1. Basic Profile of The College

The Govt. College Ani is a countryside college situated in the pristine beauty of nature at *Haripur* which is 7 k.m. from Ani, the prominent tehsil headquarter of this area in district Kullu popularly known as Outer Seraj. It came into being in June 17, 2006 with tireless efforts of the local people under leadership of octogenarian social worker Late Sh. Hari Ram. The college complex is spread over an area of nearly 23.6 bighas of land donated by the villagers who were keen on bringing transformation through education in this remote locality of the state. The college building is beautifully designed in the background of hill landscape and the college shifted to the present campus in 31st August, 2012.

The college is co-educational institution duly affiliated to the Himachal Pradesh University Shimla. Initially the college started its functioning with Arts stream only from the academic session 2006–07. The commerce faculty was introduced in the academic session 2014–15 and science faculty started its functioning from the session 2016–17. The number of students is increasing every year because of the good infrastructural facilities, remarkable teaching standard and amiable environment of the institute where they get an opportunity for all round development.

In the college, students participate actively in co-curricular activities, NSS, Rovers & Rangers, and mark their winning participation at various state and national level competitions. The college magazine '*SerajVani*' provides an opportunity to the students to express their creative skills. Various clubs and societies formed in the college provide the students with a platform to show their brilliance, and to make their college experience memorable and unforgettable. The college has developed all modern facilities of sports which includes; Boxing ring, Kabaddi Mat, Mats for High Jump, Pole Vault and Judo, Table for Table Tennis, Specious class rooms, laboratories, smart classrooms, computer lab, conference hall equipped with CCTV cameras, AC Office/Staff Room/ E-Library, playground with neat and clean, and green campus.

The college is still in its infancy stage, yet it has made great strides in the field of academics, cultural and sports activities over the short span of time. During the session 2022 – 23 our college secured the first position in HPU Youth Festival Group – II (Folk Orchestra) competition for fifth time.

The college aims at the overall development of the students by ensuring their participation in all cultural, sports and other extra co-curricular activities along with the excellence in the academics. Highly qualified and experienced faculty members are making their continuous efforts in shaping the future of the students. At present this college is catering to the needs of interior areas of District Mandi, Shimla besides Ani in District Kullu. It has proved a boon to the poor students of these areas in general and girl students in particular as more than 60 per cent girls are on its roll.

With the continuous efforts of faculty and students very soon this college will achieve academic excellence, intellectual vigor, culture and moral sensitivity, and will make this journey of learning an ‘Unstoppable Voyage’.
