7th March 2025

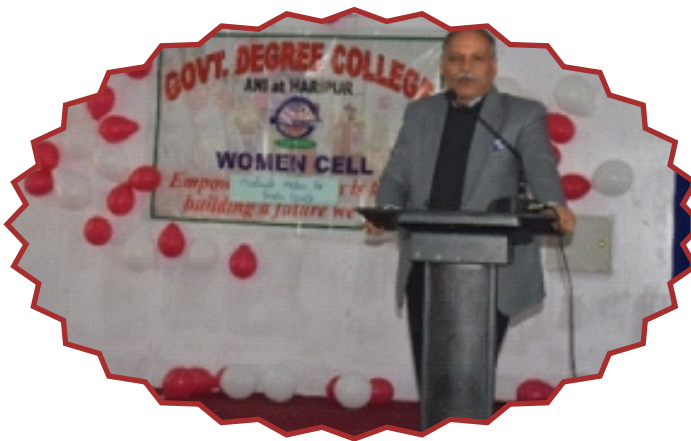

11th March 2025

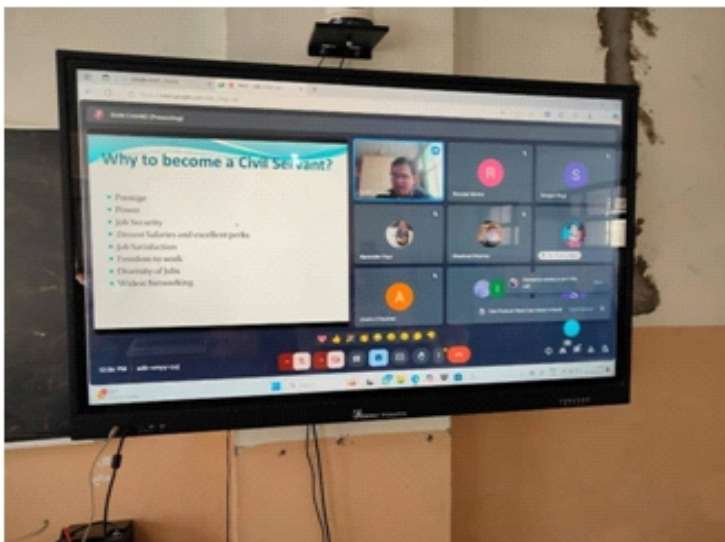
