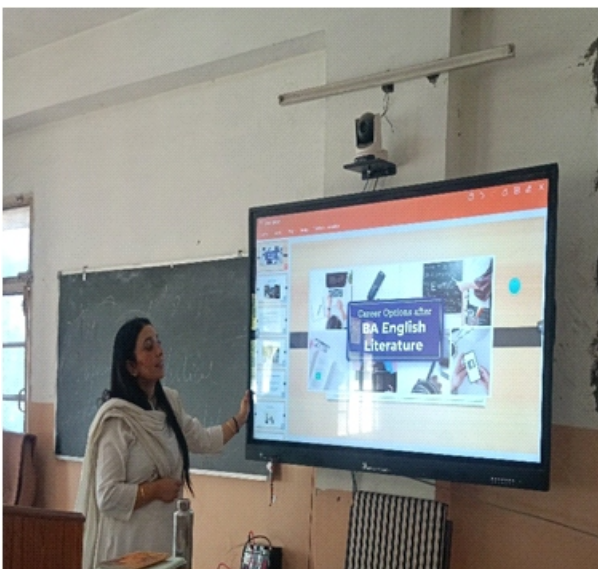
Words to Work: Career Guidance for Literature Students

14th October 2024

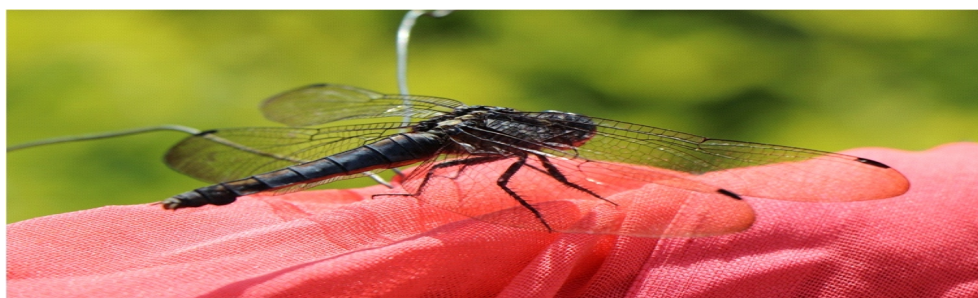
